1 SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

2 The amendments made by this Act shall apply with 3 respect to wages earned, and self-employment income de-4 rived, before, on, or after the date of the enactment of this Act. Notwithstanding section 215(f)(1) of the Social 5 6 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 415(f)(1)), as soon as practicable 7 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Commis-8 sioner of Social Security shall recompute all primary insurance amounts to the extent necessary to carry out such 9 10 amendments. Such amendments shall affect benefits only 11 for months after the date of the enactment of this Act.
