Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Four Lakes Restoration-Dam Operations Building in fiscal year 2027.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Four Lakes Special Assessment District located at 6000 S M-30, Beaverton, Michigan, 48612. The funding would be used to fund the construction of an operations building for the long-term sustainability of dam maintenance and operations.

This request is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will ensure the long-term success of the lakes restored and managed by the Four Lakes Special Assessment District, and will ensure safe operations, efficient management, and transparent engagement with the community. The current facility used by the Four Lakes Special Assessment District is in extreme disrepair and no longer meets the operational needs of the organization. Aging infrastructure, structural deficiencies, outdated mechanical systems, and general deterioration make the building increasingly difficult and costly to maintain, increasing community risk. The project has a Federal Nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 306 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S. Code section 1926(a).
