Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for Village of Edmore Water Infrastructure Improvements in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Village of Edmore, located at 209 South Sheldon Street, Edmore, MI 48829. The funding would be used for replacing approximately 5,750 linear feet of undersized and failing watermain within the Village of Edmore by installing 3,000 feet of 10-inch watermain and 2,750 feet of 8-inch watermain to restore system reliability, pressure, and overall capacity. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it restores reliability, safety, and long-term sustainability to the Village of Edmore's municipal drinking water system.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
