- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Patrick and Barbara

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1	SEC. 2. PENALTY FOR CONTRACTING WITH UNSAFE CAR-
2	RIER.
3	(a) In General.—Chapter 149 of title 49, United
4	States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
5	lowing:
6	"§ 14917. Penalty for contracting with unsafe carrier
7	"(a) In General.—Any broker under this part that
8	contracts with any specified transportation company shall
9	be liable to the United States for a civil penalty in an
10	amount equal to 10 percent of the value of the contracted
11	cargo for the entire contract of such broker with the speci-
12	fied transportation company.
13	"(b) Deposit in Highway Trust Fund.—The Sec-
14	retary shall deposit any penalty collected under subsection
15	(a) into the Highway Trust Fund.
16	"(c) USE OF FUNDS.—The Secretary may use
17	amounts deposited under subsection (b) without further
18	appropriation for projects or infrastructure eligible under
19	this title or title 23 that increase roadway safety.
20	"(d) Specified Transportation Company De-
21	FINED.—In this section, the term 'specified transportation
22	company' means a person that transports cargo for com-
23	pensation that, in the 5 year period ending on the date

24 on which a broker contracts with the specified transpor-

1	"(1) has been issued 3 or more Department of
2	Transportation violations; or
3	"(2) employs a driver that has been issued 3 or

5	"§ 14918. Investigations of certain crashes
6	"(a) In General.—The Administrator of the Fed-
7	eral Motor Carrier Safety Administration may investigate
8	a freight broker following a fatal crash by a company con-
9	tracted by such freight broker.
10	"(b) Additional Safety Requirements.—Fol-
11	lowing an investigation conducted pursuant to subsection
12	(a), the Administrator may establish additional operating
13	requirements on a freight broker if the Administrator
14	found in such investigation that the broker acted with
15	egregious disregard for safety in contracting the company
16	that was involved in such accident.".
